You can check in your car beginning at 5:15 PM and the races will follow.

How Do I Enter?

To participate in the Pinewood Derby Races, simply select this option on your convention registration form. You can register online at www.nebraskarealtors.com, or send in the registration form you received in the mail.

Registration deadline is April 1!

You can enter as an individual, or gather friends in your office and enter a team car. Please note, we will not be able to accept registrations on site for the Pinewood Derby races—so get your cars ready and sign up for the fun!

What is the Cost?

All Nebraska REALTORS® members can register for annual convention for free...**and there is no fee to register for the Pinewood Derby Races.** The only cost will be if you need to purchase a pinewood derby car kit (approx. \$4—which includes pine block, wheels & axles). ***If you already have a Pinewood Derby Car—you can just use that!***

Where Can I Purchase a Car Kit?

- Omaha - The Durham Scout Shop, located at 124th and West Maple
- Walton - Cornhusker Council office, located at 600 S. 120th Street (serves Lincoln and surrounding area)

- Hobby Town - with locations in Grand Island, La Vista, Lincoln and Omaha
- Hobby Lobby - with locations in Grand Island, Kearney, La Vista, Lincoln, Norfolk and Omaha

What Are the Rules for Building a Car?

To be as fair and consistent as possible, we'll follow the cub scout pinewood derby car regulations for car weight, height, length, etc. **The official Boy Scouts of America Pinewood Derby car kits come with building instructions.**

General Building Rules Include: cars should weigh as close to, but not over 5 ounces. Length shall not exceed 7 inches, maximum height is 3 inches and maximum car width is 2 1/4 inches with 1 3/4 inches between wheels. The cars need to maintain a 3/8 inch clearance under the bottom of the car to clear the track guide. Wheel bearings, washers and bushings are prohibited. No lubricating oil may be used. Axels may be lubricated with powdered graphite or silicone. The car shall not ride on any kind of a spring. If weights are used under the car, it is recommended the weights are recessed.
